KEY STEPS TO SILVER



- » Dedicate more staff time to bicycle planning and programming. A community of Huntington Beach's size needs a full-time bike program manager.
- » Adopt standards for bike parking that conform to APBP guidelines.
- » Increase the amount of high quality bicycle parking throughout the community.
- » Continue to expand the on and off street bike network and to increase network connectivity.
- » Develop a more formal Safe Routes to School program.
- » Continue to expand your public education campaign promoting the share the road message, especially by adding

signage along popular cycling routes.

- » Expand encouragement efforts during Bike Month.
- » Promote cycling throughout the year by offering or supporting more family-oriented community or social rides.
- » Encourage Golden West College to promote cycling to students, staff, and faculty.
- » Design and publish a local bike map in paper and online.
- » Ensure that police officers are initially and repeatedly educated on traffic law as it applies to bicyclists and motorists.
- » Ensure that there is dedicated funding for the implementation of the bike plan.
