KEY STEPS TO GOLD



- » Adopt standards for bike parking that conform to APBP guidelines.
- » Increase the amount of high quality bicycle parking throughout the community, especially at businesses.
- » Develop an on-street bike network, consider closing the historic downtown to vehicle traffic during tourist season (excepting residents living downtown), and connect the historic downtown to the major bike paths of the island.
- » Continue to expand your public education campaign promoting the share the road message, eg place share the road signs along collector roads and throughout downtown, and produce a ferry operator PSA.

- » Implement the plans to offer regular bicycling skills training opportunities for adults.
- » Host a League Cycling Instructor (LCI) seminar or sponsor the certification fee for interested cyclists to increase the number of certified bicycle safety instructors in your community.
- » Expand your promotional efforts during Bike Month, and celebrate Bike to Work Day.
- » Promote cycling throughout the year by offering or supporting more family-oriented community or social rides, and bicycle-themed festivals, parades or shows.
- » Update the current bike plan and dedicate funding for implementation.
