## COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS



» Over the last year the majority of construction (6 years of construction) on the Indianapolis Cultural Trail was completed. The Trail is an eight mile separated cycle track that connects all of Indianapolis' major cultural districts, three major greenways and our on-street bicycle network. This has not only connected our existing bicycle facilities, but it also spurred the construction of our

first physically-separated, bi-directional on-street cycletrack to make a vital connection to a nearby greenway (<http://www.indyculturaltrail.org/>). We also opened our Indy Bike Hub (<http://indybikehub.org/>), striped over 10 additional miles of on street bikeways and installed our first bike boxes.
