

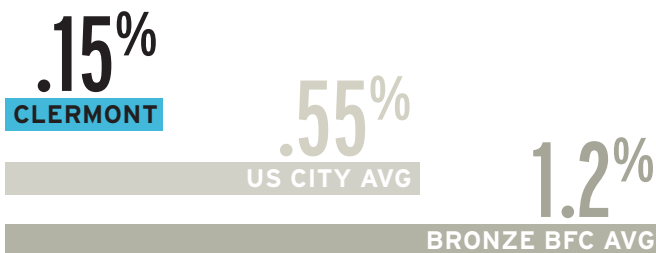

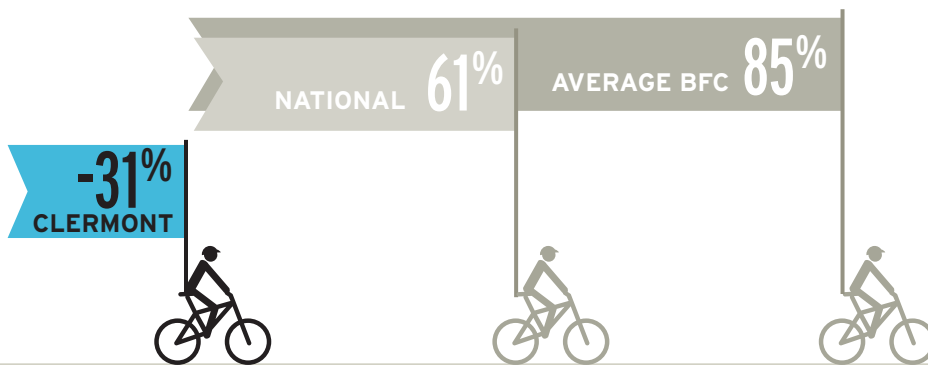

Every community excels in different areas, but the important thing is continued progress on these key fronts. If you see these signs in your community, Clermont could be ready for Bronze!

FEEDBACK

Expand the bike network and increase network connectivity with use of bike lanes, protected bike lanes, bike boulevards and wayfinding signage.

Consider routing a trail extension through downtown to improve connectivity and economic development.

Set a high target for ridership and safety, and create a public outreach campaign to engage general public.
