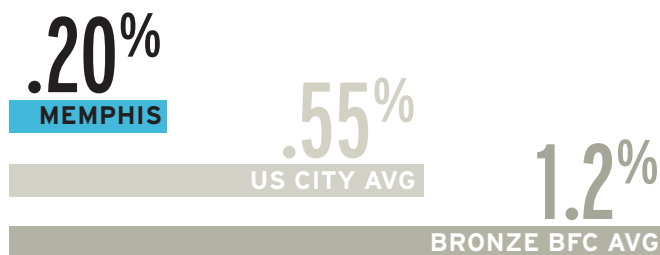




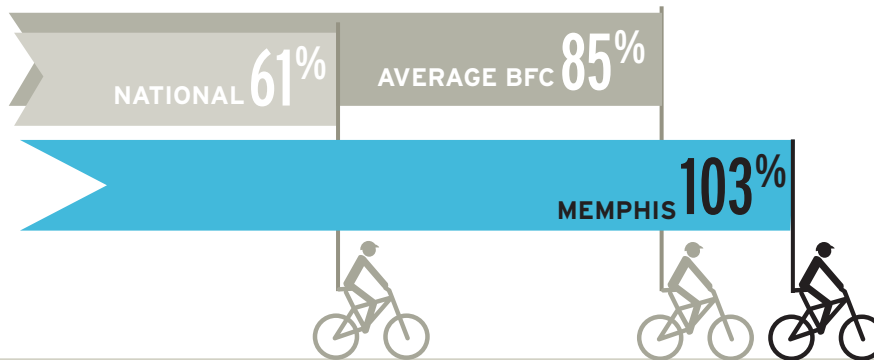

FEEDBACK

Expand the bike network and increase network connectivity through the use of bike facilities like bike lanes, buffered bike lanes and protected bike lanes especially on major roads

Implement bold plan to create more cycle tracks/protected bike lanes

Budget for more far-reaching marketing and awareness campaigns
