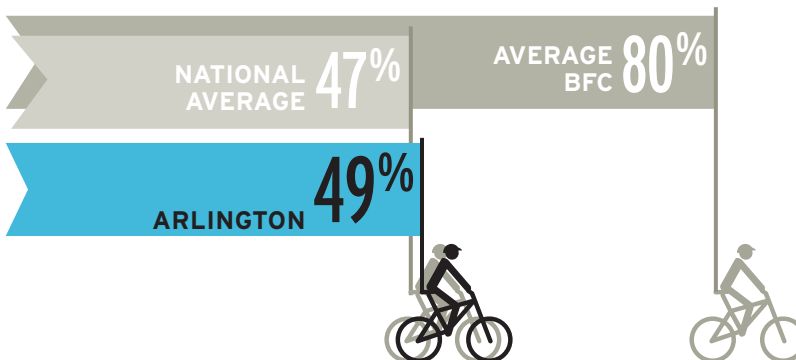

FEEDBACK

Expand on-street bikeway network through road diets and the narrowing of lanes

Implement Safe Routes to School program that includes bicycling education in all elementary schools

Ensure that all bike lanes are built to optimal width by narrowing travel lanes to 11' or less
