

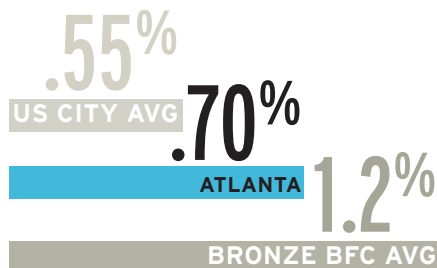

U.S. Census Bureau ACS

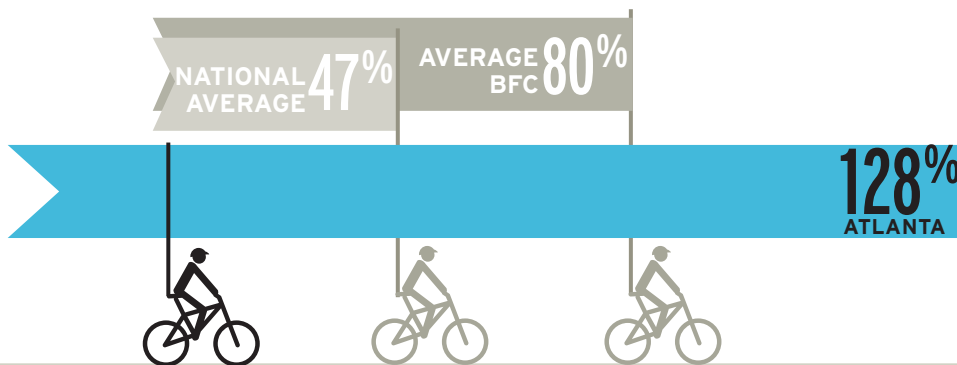

FEEDBACK

Devote more staff time at city and regional level aimed at improving conditions for walking and bicycling.

Continue to expand on-street network especially with buffered and protected bike lanes in downtown area; more road diets!

Obtain funding to advance bicycling education and SRTS programs in as many schools as possible.
