

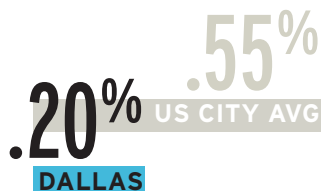

CURRENT RIDERSHIP



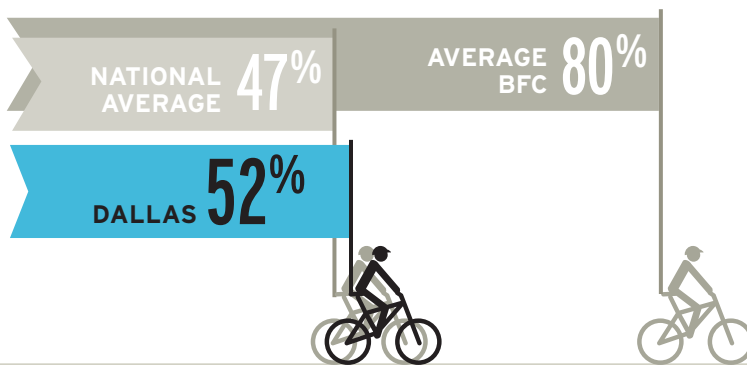

FEEDBACK

Create more on-street connections to off-street trails with wayfinding, bike lanes, etc.

Improve bike network in downtown area and consider protected bike lanes to attract more users

Increase ridership through bike to work day, incentives and other encouragement efforts.
