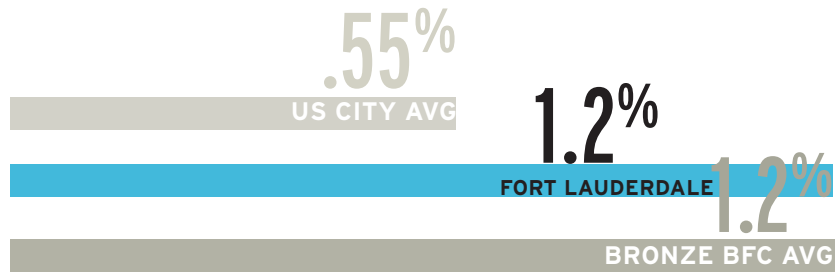




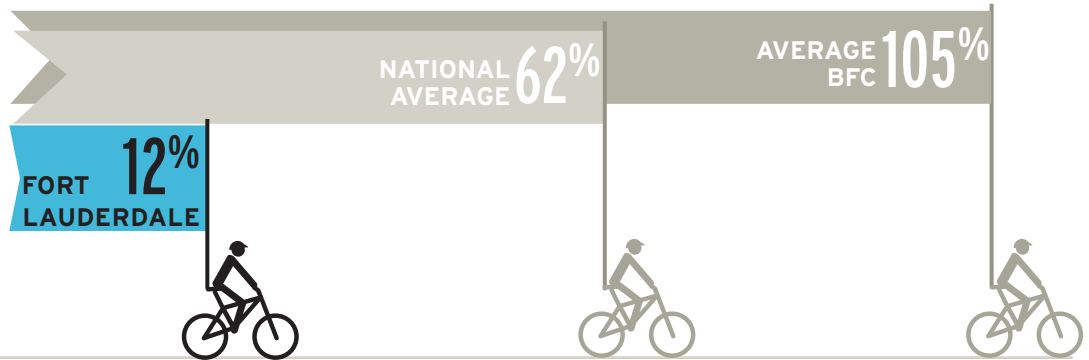

10 BUILDING BLOCKS OF A BICYCLE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY

Every community excels in different areas, but the important thing is continued progress on these key fronts.


FEEDBACK

Widen or buffer existing bike lanes where travel lanes exceed 11' in width

Expand network and map of family-friendly bikeways including bike boulevards and add protected bike lanes on high speed/volume streets

Implement youth education and encouragement programs in as many schools as possible

Institute bicycle advisory committee to help oversee comprehensive approach
