

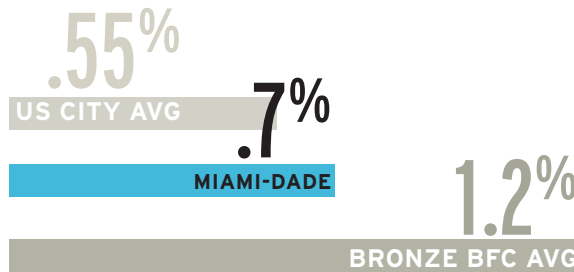

U.S. Census Bureau ACS

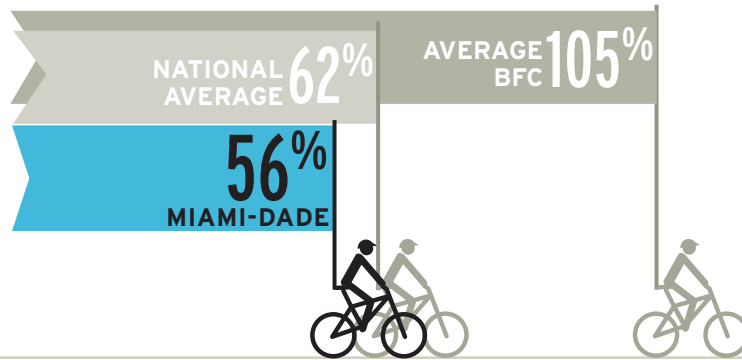

## 10 BUILDING BLOCKS OF A BICYCLE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY

Every community excels in different areas, but the important thing is continued progress on these key fronts.

### FEEDBACK

Make the safety of cyclists and pedestrians a higher priority than the speed of motorists

Ensure that bike lanes are as wide as possible (or buffered/protected) by narrowing or eliminating bike lanes, especially on causeways like Rickenbacher

Launch major public awareness campaign legitimizing rights of cyclists to use all roadways

Continue to expand bikeway network, especially on arterials where no other options exist
