

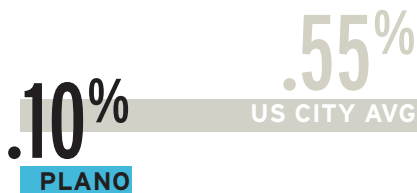

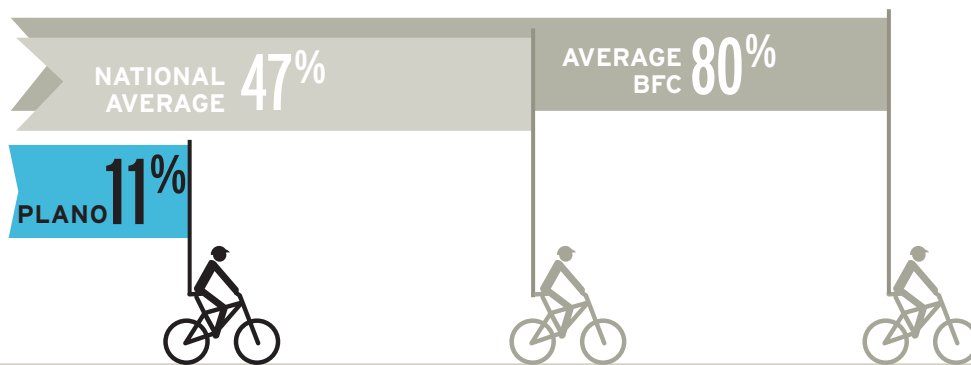

FEEDBACK

Develop on-street bikeway network including bicycle boulevards and bike lanes where appropriate

Where width is insufficient for regular bike lanes employ advisory bike lanes

Expand education and encouragement efforts through increased staffing/resources for bicycle program
