

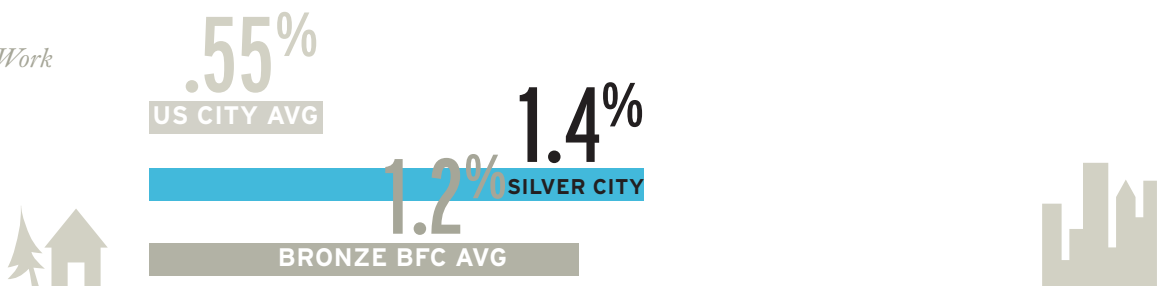

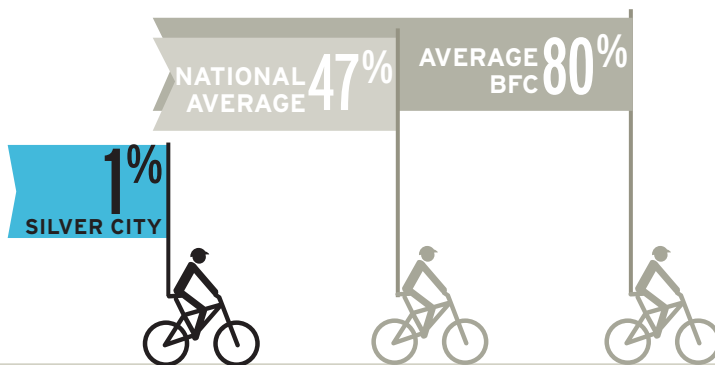
Percentage of Residents Biking to Work

10 BUILDING BLOCKS OF A BICYCLE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY

Every community excels in different areas, but the important thing is continued progress on these key fronts.

FEEDBACK

Adopt a Complete Streets policy, close gaps and expand the on-street and off-street bikeway network including bike lanes, buffered bike lanes, bike boulevards and paths.

Continue to use road diets and traffic calming to improve bicyclist safety and comfort.

Launch a public bicycle-friendly Silver City campaign that includes public bicycling education outreach and highlights the bicycling amenities already in place
