

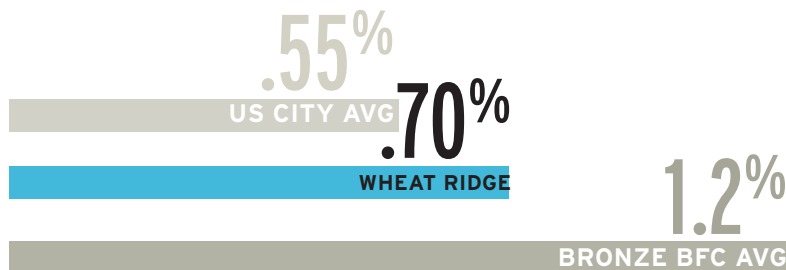

U.S. Census Bureau ACS

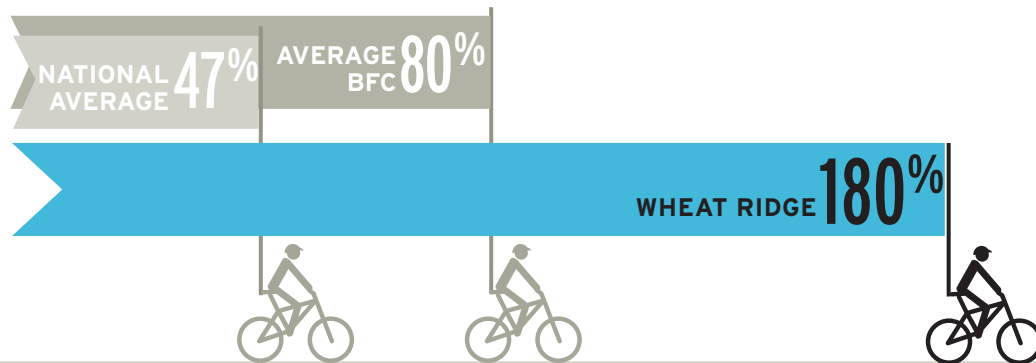

Every community excels in different areas, but the important thing is continued progress on these key fronts.

FEEDBACK

Consider amending Bicycle/Pedestrian Master Plan (2010) to better reflect best practices in bikeway design

Devote more staff time and resources for plan implementation

Begin by providing quality on-street bike facilities and wayfinding on key streets that tie into Denver's bike infrastructure and to popular destination points
