## KEY STEPS TO GOLD



- » Continue to increase the amount of high quality bicycle parking throughout the community, particularly at multi-family housing and retail destinations and restaurants.
- » Continue to expand the on and off street bike network, especially along arterials, and to increase network connectivity. On roads with posted speed limits of more than 35 mph, it is recommended to provide protected bicycle infrastructure.
- » Install a bicycle wayfinding system with distance and destination information.
- » Adequately maintain your on and off road bicycle infrastructure to ensure usability and safety.
- » Expand the Safe Routes to School program.

- » Continue to expand your public education campaign promoting the share the road message.
- » Offer bicycling skills training opportunities for adults more frequently.
- » Promote cycling throughout the year by offering or supporting more family-oriented community or social rides.
- » Coconino County Sheriff's Department needs to be brought up to speed on cycling laws and should begin more active enforcement of speed limits on Lake Mary Road.
- » Police should report crash data and hazards
- » Adopt and implement the proposed bike plan.
