KEY STEPS TO SILVER



- » Appoint an official Bicycle Advisory Committee.
- » Upgrade current bike parking to comply with standards. Improve bike parking throughout the community, especially at government offices, public facilities such as recreation centers & libraries, and at private businesses. Add covered bike parking throughout downtown for commuters.
- » Calm traffic speeds.
- » Expand your on street bike network. Upgrade bike lanes along higher speed roads to protected bike lanes. Make sure all new and current infrastructure meet AASHTO standards.
- » Reliably clear roads and bike paths of snow and debris, restripe as needed

- » Continue to expand your public education campaign promoting the share the road message.
- » Offer bicycling skills training opportunities for adults, especially about inclement weather riding.
- » Encourage the University of Alaska to promote cycling to students, staff, and faculty.
- » Design and publish a local bike map in paper and online.
- » Ask police officers to target both motorist and cyclist infractions.
- » Update the 2009 bike plan. Ensure to include implementation strategies.
