## COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS



» Santa Monica adopted and began to implement a Bike Action Plan. The Plan won awards from the American Planning Association at the State and local levels, and has resulted in significant implementation including the nation's largest bike center, free bicycle education classes every month, an LCI course, creation of a bike campus with on-line video lessons, bikeway improvements that

doubled the lanes, sharrows and racks available in the City and included the first green lanes and bike boxes, expanded bike to work events, developer requirements and employer incentives. Behind these achievements is a developing partnership between the City, bike activists and the broader community, which serves as a real engine towards change.
