

Tips for promoting your Bicycle Friendly Community Public Survey Link

Thank you for helping the <u>Bicycle Friendly Community</u> review team better understand your community by gaining valuable public input from residents, local bicyclists, and bike advocates. Below are some tips and ideas for how to distribute your survey locally to reach the most people and have the greatest impact. The League of American Bicyclists will also distribute the survey to our network of local bike advocates and League members in your area.

- Post a brief article about the survey link and pursuing the BFC status on your city or town's official website.
- Send a press release to local media outlets.
- Post the survey link to your city or town's official social media sites, including Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, etc.
 - Examples from previous years are included on pages below!
- Ask other groups to share the link on their social media pages as well. Provide them with sample language in addition to the link. Potential partners include:
 - Local transit agency, bike/walk advocacy groups, chamber of commerce, Friends of Trails groups, downtown business districts, local bike shops, and local Bicycle Friendly Businesses.
- Post to neighborhood listservs, online forums, or services like <u>Nextdoor</u>.
- Announce at upcoming BPAC and City Council meetings, and be sure the survey link is included on the official meeting minutes published afterwards.
