



Questions to Consider

- Budget
- Riding purpose

Accessories

- Fenders
- Dynamo lights (built in)
- Rear rack, front rack, basket, etc.

Options

- Road
- Mountain
- Fat bike
- Hybrid/Comfort
- Electric
- Recumbent
- Tandem
- Folding
- Cargo

BIKE

Where to look

- Local bike shop (new or used)
- FB Marketplace and other local selling groups
- Online (direct to consumer or not)

GEAR

- Bike
- Lock
- Helmet
- Carrying system
 - backpack, rear rack, panniers, milk crate, front rack
- Lights & reflectors
- Clothing & gear for specific weather
 - studded tires, fenders, rain cape/jacket, waterproof shoes, bar mitts, etc.

ROUTE & RESOURCES

Basic bike skills

- MUST HAVE
 - ABC Quick Check
 - How to lock a bike securely (& where to lock up)
 - Road safety (lane position, hand signals, etc.)
- Nice to have
 - How to fix a flat

Bike repair plan

 If you run into an issue, where will you get it fixed (local bike shop, friend, mobile mechanic)?

Backup transportation plan

 If you encounter an issue while riding, what is your back up plan to get to your destination? (transit, phone a friend, walk, etc.)

ROUTE & RESOURCES

- Bike Insurance
- Routing
 - Be wary of Google/Apple maps
 - Recommended: Pointz, Transit App, Strava heat maps
- Find your community
 - Group rides, events, advocacy orgs, online forums, etc.
